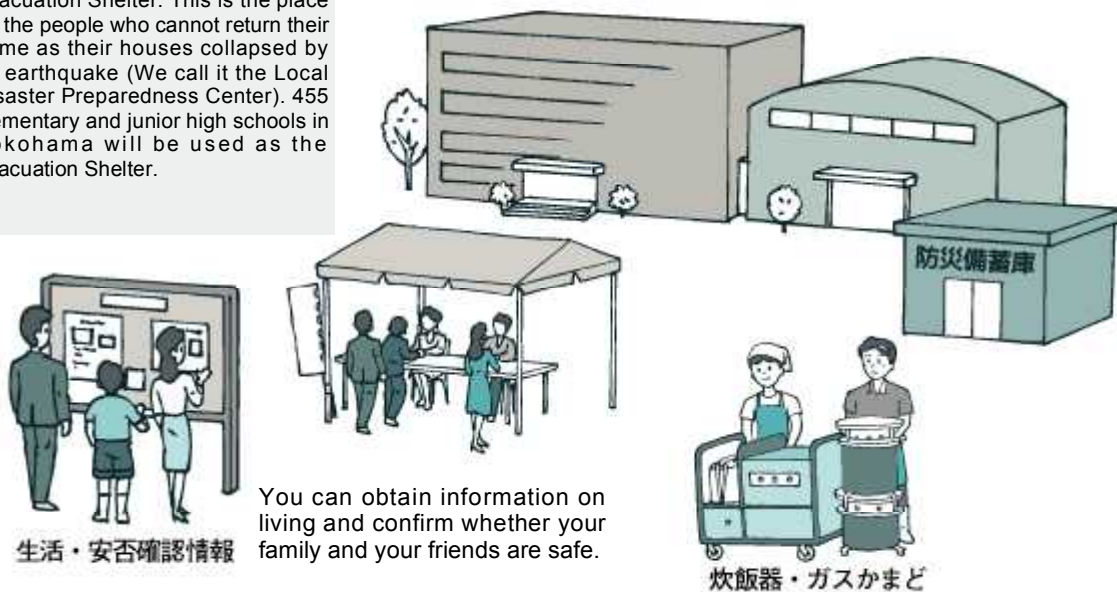

If an earthquake occurs you should evacuate to an Evacuation Shelter. Evacuation Shelter: This is the place for the people who cannot return their home as their houses collapsed by an earthquake (We call it the Local Disaster Preparedness Center). 455 elementary and junior high schools in Yokohama will be used as the Evacuation Shelter.

Local residents will manage the shelter.

The steering committee is set up at each shelter in order to manage it with cooperation. The committee consists of the local residents, school and administration.

You can obtain information on living and confirm whether your family and your friends are safe.

Evacuation Shelter has a storage.

The City of Yokohama has prepared food such as canned biscuit/water, daily necessities such as toilet paper, equipment or materials for temporary toilet and engine cutter in storage of each shelter.

Water is secured at the places as follows just in case.

- Underground Water Tank for Disaster・・・The Underground Receiving Tanks are installed to provide fresh drinking water.
- Emergency Water Supply Tap・・・The facility to provide water through the quake-resistant water pipes.
- Cooperative Household with the private well・・・Cooperate with the households which have the private wells.

When you are injured

The Local Medical Aid Center which provides emergency treatment will be set up at 145 primary schools. The necessities for emergency treatment such as medicines are prepared at the centers.
